Dear Parents, Carers and students,

Thank you for your support in our first day of Remote Learning. It appears to have been a very positive day.

As Mentor teachers, we appreciated the meeting with our Mentor students in Period 4 and it was impressive to see how most of our students had managed the day, with its virtual meetings and remote learning tasks.

Just a few reminders:

- Students must attend their virtual PC at 11.20am every day to be marked present for the day. If students are not present in PC, they will be marked absent, and, from tomorrow, parents will be sent notification of absence which will need to be explained. - Student work set needs to be completed and submitted. This is essential as proof of attendance and engagement in their learning. If students have questions or are experiencing difficulty with the work, they are encouraged to email their teacher who will respond to them as soon as they are able.
- Your Mentor teacher is a key source of support during Remote Learning - both for students and for parents and carers. Do not hesitate to contact your Mentor teacher with any concerns or queries you may have.
