Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may have heard, the ACT Lockdown has been extended until Thursday 2 September. This means that students need to settle in to remote learning for the next three weeks. Given the extended time, it is most important that our students are able to engage in their learning from the start and that they feel comfortable that they have what they need to manage their learning.

Given the longer duration of the Lockdown, there may well be equipment that can be made available to students to support their learning. We envisage that this will be particularly for students in Years 11 & 12. We will develop a list of what will be available for pick up for different class groups and the arrangements for how this can be accessed in the near future.

I have attached again the list of instructions that were sent to students on Friday - these are also on Moodle and Sentral messages. Just a few more instructions:

- Please go to your Moodle House page to access your PC virtual meeting each day. This is also where you will find the link for your Mentor lesson each week.
- A reminder of student etiquette required for virtual meetings:
 - Students must have their camera turned on throughout the meeting, with the background blurred.
 - Our preference is that students will have their virtual meetings in an open area of the house. If they do need to have the meeting in their bedroom, it must be at their desk with the door open.

As mentioned, if your child needs to work at school, please let us know through the office. If your circumstances change and you require this at some point in the Lockdown, please alert us to this before sending them to school.
